## **Municipal Court to host open house**

WEATHERFORD (CITY OF WEATHERFORD), Texas — The City of Weatherford Municipal Court will host an open house for public viewing of its new courtroom Tuesday, April 28.

The event will begin at 10 a.m. and conclude at 4 p.m. The courtroom is located in City Hall at 303 Palo Pinto St.

The new 40 seat municipal courtroom features include the judge's bench and state-of-the-art audio/video monitors that provide the ability to display video evidence as well as court decorum. The public will have the opportunity to meet municipal court judges and staff during the open house.

“With our new courtroom, we are not competing with any other city boards for use of the council chambers, where court was previously held,” said Judge Robert Galbreath. “We will be able to expedite our jury trial docket as well as speedier juvenile, pre-trial, indigent and show cause hearings. I would like to thank Parker County officials Sheriff Larry Fowler, Judge Mark Riley and Judge Wayne Hayes for assistance in the donation of the judge's bench.”
