## **Parks, Recreation and Special Events to host public input meeting**

WEATHERFORD (CITY OF WEATHERFORD), Texas — The City of Weatherford Parks, Recreation and Special Events Department will hold a public input meeting Thursday, Feb. 4, at 6 p.m. to assist in the creation of the Park Master Plan and Trail Master Plan.

Citizen comments will be heard during the public input meeting to address park and recreation needs within the City of Weatherford. The input meeting will also allow citizens the opportunity to learn more about the planning process.

“The Park Master Plan and Trail Master Plan is an important tool for the City of Weatherford,” said Director of Parks, Recreation and Special Events Shannon Goodman. “We currently have 18 parks and manage 856 acres of city property within the city limits. It is important that our plan for the future includes input from our citizens to better understand our overall needs.”

The Weatherford Parks, Recreation and Special Events Department is committed to enriching the quality of life through exceptional programs, parks and facilities while preserving the community’s natural environment for the enjoyment of current and future citizens.

Once completed the Park Master Plan and Trail Master Plan will provide a 10 year layout for the City of Weatherford’s park system. The meeting will be held at the City of Weatherford City Hall, located at 303 Palo Pinto Street.
