## **Settlement and boundary agreement reached between the City of Weatherford, Towns of Brock, Brock West and Dennis**

WEATHERFORD (CITY OF WEATHERFORD), Texas - The City of Weatherford reached a settlement and boundary agreement with the Towns of Brock, Brock West and Dennis bringing litigation to an end.

The agreement was finalized with the adoption of an ordinance during the most recent Weatherford City Council meeting held Tuesday, June 13. The ordinance establishes a Common Boundary Line separating the existing and future corporate territory and extraterritorial jurisdiction for all cities included in the lawsuit. It further details Weatherford's commitment to discontinue corporate jurisdiction and reduce extraterritorial jurisdiction.

"We are glad that an agreement was finally reached," said City Manager Sharon Hayes. "Our mission has always been about protecting Weatherford's interests to the west. For approximately 10 years the City of Weatherford has been placing infrastructure toward the west in anticipation of growth. We had to protect our investment and future. We owed that to our taxpayers and community."

The agreement comes after months of litigation and discussion that were fueled by ongoing land growth concerns from all parties. The agreement was additionally finalized with approval from Parker County.
