



TEMPORARY SIGN AND BANNER PERMIT APPLICATION

One temporary banner is allowed for each property (or each store-front on a multi-use property) in Commercial or Industrial Zones. A temporary banner or feather flag may be displayed no longer than 90 days per calendar year. Banners may not exceed 32 square feet and feather flag type banners may not exceed 15 feet in height. One feather flag is allowed per business in addition to one temporary banner. Signs may not be located within the right-of-way or within a clear sight triangle.

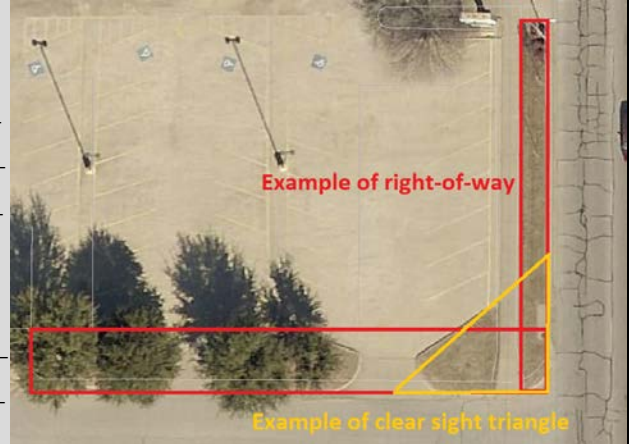
