Plan Submission Requirements

Contractors must be registered with the City of Weatherford Department of Neighborhood Services (DNS) prior to plan submittal.

All Codes and Standards shall be at a minimum of the current code/standard adopted by the City of Weatherford.

All plans are to be submitted electronically.

Propane Tank (LP Gas)

- Completed permit application.
- Site plan showing the location of the proposed LP tank
- LP tank data
- Installation shall be in accordance with International Fire Code and NFPA 58.

Underground Fire Line

- Completed permit application.
- General RME signed and stamped plans indicating location of fire line and compliant to NFPA 13 & current adopted International Fire Codes.
- Copy of contractor's Texas Department of Insurance License.
- Copy of contractor's Liability Insurance with City of Weatherford as the certificate holder.

Underground Storage Tank (Installation/Removal)

- Completed permit application.
- Signed and stamped plans to include location and tank specifications/cut sheets.
- Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) permit.
- Copy of contractor's TCEQ License.
- Copy of contractor's Liability Insurance with City of Weatherford as the certificate holder.

Fire Alarm / Fire Sprinkler /Access Control

- Must be approved by a city approved third-party Fire Prevention Engineer (FPE) reviewer prior to submittal.
- Completed permit application.
- FPE signed, stamped, & approved plans including equipment specifications/cut sheets and square footage of the area in which work is being performed.
- Copy of Texas Fire Alarm APS License (Fire Alarms)
- Copy of contractor's Liability Insurance with City of Weatherford as the certificate holder.

Tent (Temporary Membrane Structure)

- Completed permit application.
- Site plan showing the location of the proposed temporary membrane structure and compliant to International Fire Code and International Building Code.
- Construction material must be ANSI approved for flame propagation per NFPA 701.

Plan Submission Requirements

Hood System Installation

- Completed permit application.
- Signed and stamped plans including equipment specifications/cut sheets and kitchen layout.
- A copy of the applicable State of Texas Fire Extinguisher license is required for the designing contractor, Type PL, A, or K.
- A copy of State of Texas Fire Extinguisher ECR license is required for the installing company.
- Copy of contractor’s Liability Insurance with City of Weatherford as the certificate holder.

Fireworks

- Completed permit application.
- Site plan showing the location of the proposed pyrotechnics display with proper stand-off distances and in accordance with NFPA 1123 & NFPA 1126.
- Shot count and detail of pyrotechnics.
- Copy of Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) Pyrotechnics Operators License.
- If fireworks are 1.3G, provide all documentation required by Chapter 2154 of the Texas Occupations Code and Texas Administrative Code Title 28
 - Completed copy of SF044 form in PDF format.
 - Copy of TDI approved permit.
- Copy of contractor’s Liability Insurance with City of Weatherford as the certificate holder.

Open Burning

- Completed permit application
- Site must be zoned agricultural (Check weatherfordtx.gov/map/ to verify)
- Site plan indicating location of open burning and adjacent structures. (Google Earth Image)
 - Cannot be within of 300’ of any structures.
 - Subject to Fire Marshal Site Inspection
