<b>Meter Test Fee</b>	
Water – In-house (up to 1" meter)	1st Test Free, \$60 (if meter does not test within AWWA standards, no charge)
Water – 3 <sup>rd</sup> Party (any meter size)	Actual Cost (if meter does not test within AWWA standards, no charge)
Electric – In-house	1st Test Free, \$60 (if meter does not test within ANSI/IEEE standards, no charge)
Electric – 3 <sup>rd</sup> Party	Actual Cost (if meter does not test within ANSI/IEEE standards, no charge)
<b>Meter Re-Reads</b>	
2 free per year; If City is wrong it does not count against 2 free; If City was correct, then fee applies	\$43 per re-read
<b>Credit/Debit Card Processing Fee</b>	
Processing fee for Utility Payments paid with a credit or debit card	2% of charge
