

Utility Customer Service Policy

Schedule of Fees: Schedule A

Meter Test Fee

Water	In-House – 1 st Test Free, \$30 (if meter does not test within AWWA standards, no charge) Third Party – Actual Cost (if meter does not test within AWWA standards, no charge)
Electric	In-House - 1 st Test Free, \$30 (if meter does not test within ANSI/IEEE standards, no charge) Third Party - Actual Cost (if meter does not test within ANSI/IEEE standards, no charge)

Security Deposit (Half, at minimum, is due upon application and any remaining amount is billed on up to the first four statements.)

Residential Service Includes Electric Service

- Two month average of residence or similar sized residence with a maximum of \$400.00, or
- A letter of reference from a similar utility (i.e. if electric service is included the previous electric provider) for the twelve (12) months prior with perfect payment history, or
- A Certification Letter for Victim of Family Violence Waiver for Electric and Telephone Service Deposit, or
- A City Manager approved co-signer within a second degree on the consanguinity kinship chart that has an active account with the City.
- With twelve (12) months of perfect consecutive payment history, zero (0) penalties, zero (0) cutoffs, zero (0) returned checks and/or ACH rejections; the deposit will be refunded via check and mailed.

Residential Service Excludes Electric Service

- Two month average of residence or similar sized residence with a maximum of \$200.00, or
- A letter of reference from a similar utility for the twelve (12) months prior with perfect payment history, or
- A City Manager approved co-signer within a second degree on the consanguinity kinship chart that has an active account with the City.
- With twelve (12) months of perfect consecutive payment history, zero (0) penalties, zero (0) cutoffs, zero (0) returned checks and/or ACH rejections; the deposit will be refunded via check and mailed.

Residential Services for The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) - \$200 for the inspection process. If the purchase occurs then the additional \$200 will be billed on the account with inspection consumption. If the purchase does not occur then the remaining deposit is returned after the consumption deduction for inspection has been made.

Residential Service Addition for Previously Delinquent Account \$100.00

Residential Building additional security deposit for Water/Wastewater \$850.00

Commercial Account

- a) One-sixth (1/6) of the estimated annual billing,
- b) If the deposit required exceeds \$500.00, the applicant can provide a performance bond in the amount of the deposit, or
- c) An irrevocable letter of credit from an approved banking institution guaranteeing payment on demand to the City in the amount of the deposit.
